

Notices for eduroam users:

Per Section 3.1 of the Internet2 eduroam® Connector Agreement:

When users of the eduroam wireless network travel outside of the United States, the service provider may transfer Data (all data, including data needed to determine the identity provider system for authentication and security information, that is transmitted or processed by the eduroam service by or on behalf of Hofstra, including any Hofstra user, through Hofstra's and its user's use of the service) to third parties as needed to fulfill its obligations under its provider agreement, i.e. Data may be sent across borders and to countries or jurisdictions around the world as needed). By using the wireless network service, you consent to: (1) the use of the Data for the purposes identified herein and in the then current technical documentation and specifications for the eduroam service; and (2) the transfer of the Data within and outside of the United States, including to countries and jurisdictions around the world. By using the eduroam service, you consent to such usage.

Per Section 3.3.7 of the Internet2 eduroam® Connector Agreement:
